Preventing crime at Moat Lodge

- 1. Don't leave your keys or ID documents within easy reach of doors, letterboxes or windows.
- 2. Don't leave keys, ID or valuable items like computers, coats, money, mobile phones on show in your vehicle.
- 3. Close and lock all doors and windows in both your home and your car.
- 4. It is not advised to have 'hiding places' for keys outside of your property.
- 5. We have secure communal doors that can only be accessed via the entry system. Please do not allow entry to unknown callers and ensure the communal doors are always shut behind you.
- 6. Lock your garage at all times.
- 7. Use timer switches linked to lights and a radio so it appears that someone is at home when you are away.
- 8. Invest in a safe for valuables and sentimental items and securely fix it to a solid surface.
- 9. We have CCTV at Moat Lodge. Please report any suspicious behaviour to Moat Lodge Management.
- 10. We have low level 'dusk till dawn' lighting to increase visibility and deter burglars. Please report any bulbs that are not working to Moat Lodge Management.
- 11. As best possible we keep side and rear boundaries high to restrict access and front boundaries low to remove hiding places.
- 12. Photograph and mark valuables and sentimental items with your postcode and house number/name. Register items with serial numbers at: immobilise.com.
- 13. Get to know who your neighbours are and be aware of your surroundings, looking out for one another.
